- Population and physiology research;
- Crab trap clean-up and BRD education programs;
- Outreach efforts to reduce terrapin road mortality; and
- Gaps in policies for protection.

Break-out discussions which will follow priority topics identified at previous workshops and will be outcome oriented. In addition, interested participants can participate in the **poster display** with their research, education or conservation projects.
