

Marine Game Fish Tagging Program Monthly Summary

July 2023


Because program activity is ongoing, this report represents approximate numbers, and may not be reflective of overall activity.

During the month of July 2023, a total of 317 fish were tagged and released by 34 active participants. There were 77 recaptures reported by 74 recreational anglers (Table 1).
