Disability Licenses are only available to South Carolina residents. For the purpose of applying for a Disability License, "resident" means any person who is a citizen of the United States and who has been a domiciled (permanent) resident of the state of South Carolina for a period of one year or more immediately prior to the date of application for license. **A legible photocopy of a South Carolina driver's license or South Carolina Identification Card must accompany this application.** (Ownership of property or payment of property taxes or both does not necessarily constitute residency.)

DISABILITY CERTIFICATION

Any person who has been a domiciled resident of South Carolina for at least one year and who is determined to be **totally disabled** under one of the programs listed below may obtain a statewide fishing and hunting license or statewide fishing license at **NO COST**. It is valid only for three years from date of issue and disability recertification will be required for renewal. Check the program below that has certified you as totally disabled and attach a current year copy of such agency certification to this form, SC Code of Laws, Sec. 50-9-510 (16).
