Lifetime Licenses are only available to South Carolina residents. For the purpose of applying for a Lifetime License, "resident" means any person who is a citizen of the United States and who has been a domiciled (permanent) resident of the state of South Carolina for a period of 180 consecutive days or more immediately prior to the date of application for license. **A legible photocopy of a South Carolina driver's license or South Carolina Identification Card must accompany this application.** (Ownership of property or payment of property taxes or both does not necessarily constitute residency.)

- Age 2 to under 16 years of age (Copy of birth certificate and parent's SC Driver's License required) . \$160.00
- Age 16 to under 64 years of age \$200.00

- Lifetime Senior License (64 years of age or older).....\$9.00
