SUBJECT: 2025 Upstate Mobility Impaired Deer Hunt Application

I have enclosed an application for the 2025 Upstate Mobility Impaired Deer Hunts, a liability waiver form, and application instructions. We are planning to meet at our usual locations for both the Cherokee, Spartanburg, and Union hunt at Tyger Ranch on October 24th and the Laurens and Newberry hunt at the Clinton National Guard Armory on October 31st.

If you would like to register for the Upstate hunts this year, please return your completed application and <u>signed liability waiver form (on back of application)</u> to me by September 3, 2025. Each hunter may bring an assistant to assist them in a **non-hunting capacity only**. Assistants are allowed to help participants with their mobility needs, not harvest deer. Bringing assistants to participate in a hunting capacity may result in disqualification for future hunts. We will have liability waiver forms for assistants to sign at each hunt. I am sure there are other qualified individuals who do not attend our hunts. If you know any of individuals who would like to participate, please advise them that the application may be downloaded from our website at <u>www.dnr.sc.gov/hunting/mobilityhunt</u> and encourage them to apply. We do not have a current list of other hunts offered in SC.
