

MINUTES OF WILDLIFE RESOURCES COMMISSION MEETING AT FAIRBETTO BLUFF  
SEPTEMBER 28, 1959

Present were Commissioners Johnson, Cantey and Huggins, Director Webb, Frank Nelson and Jeff Miller.

Mr. Johnson moved that the qualification on the appointment of W. S. Murray as a Dorchester warden be removed and that he be appointed forthwith and this was adopted.

Eugene Vaughan of Barnwell was appointed game warden. W. O. Hardee of Charleston was reappointed as a non-pay warden and Elmer E. Long, Georgetown, and Robert C. Larnell, Darlington, were appointed as non-pay wardens.

The matter of management and regulations for the 12,000-acre reservoir above the present Spartanburg water works lake was discussed and it was decided to continue the matter until the next meeting, by which time Director Webb said he should have information from the Attorney General.

Director Webb was authorized to sign a lease for the one-acre access area on the Fee Dee river in Darlington county and also to approve the wording of the signs that would be placed.
