

- 1/2. Return through LE gate boats at an idle speed and single file to boat #3
- 3. Boats will approach the starboard side of LE boat and display tournament ID#
- Flight 1 Green: boats 1-34 Launch at 7:00, return at 2:00pm
- Flight 2 Blue: boats 35-68 Launch at 7:20, return at 2:20pm
- Flight 3 Yellow: boats 69-102
 Launch at 7:40, return at 2:40pm
- 4. Boats quickly and safely trailer. Livewells checked by tournament officials. Anglers will need to have their Angler Tournament Cards ready to be marked by tournament officials. Boats move to parking space to tie down. **Do not tie down on ramp or at the top of the ramp, do so once you are in your parking space.**

- 4. Boats quickly and safely trailer. Livewells checked by tournament officials. Anglers will need to have their Angler Tournament Cards ready to be marked by tournament officials. Boats move to parking space to tie down. **Do not tie down on ramp or at the top of the ramp, do so once you are in your parking space.**
- 5. Tournament officials to direct backing and maintain double file. Boats pull up from 5 and send to parking space top tie down.
- 6. As soon as these are cleared, they will check out with a DNR truck by the park's entrance and return their boat id card at this point and inform DNR staff of intentions to attend weigh in, if your anglers have fish and time of departure. Boats travel to the Fairgrounds and enter at Gate 11 only.

**Boats will need to double file to ramp to load boats. Boats will only be able to go right when leaving ramp. Trailers may only be retrieved if your boat is at the landing, ready to load. Please do not block the flow of traffic to load boats if your boat is not at the courtesy dock or ramp ready to load.
