

2024 Coyote Trapping and Management Workshop March 14-15, 2024

The South Carolina Department of Natural Resources, in conjunction with the South Carolina Trappers Association, will host a Coyote Trapping and Management Workshop at the Webb Wildlife Center, located in Hampton County on March 14-15, 2024. Sign-in and registration will begin at 1:30pm on Thursday, with the workshop starting promptly at 2:00pm. The workshop will end by approximately 5pm on Friday.

This coyote management workshop will cover such topics as:

- Coyote biology and management
- General trapping equipment
- Trap selection and modification
- Trap preparation
- Trap site selection
- Various trap sets
- Bait/lure selection and use
- Trapping safety
- Running a trap line
- Record keeping

Registered Foresters that take and complete the workshop may qualify for Category 2 Continuing Forestry Education (CFE) Credits. (Pending Approval)

No previous trapping experience is required, and persons with little or no coyote trapping experience are especially encouraged to attend. Please note that everyone attending will be expected to set traps and participate with the group, rain or shine, hot or cold. This is an extended hands-on trapping workshop for individuals who want to learn to manage coyotes, and will involve extensive outdoor participation over potentially uneven terrain.

The cost for the workshop is \$115 and includes workshop materials, overnight bunkhouse-style accommodations at the Webb Wildlife Center, dinner on Thursday, and breakfast and lunch on Friday.

The maximum number of attendees for this workshop is 30. **Registration closes when 30 people have registered and paid.** A waiting list will be created for cancellations and for future workshops.
