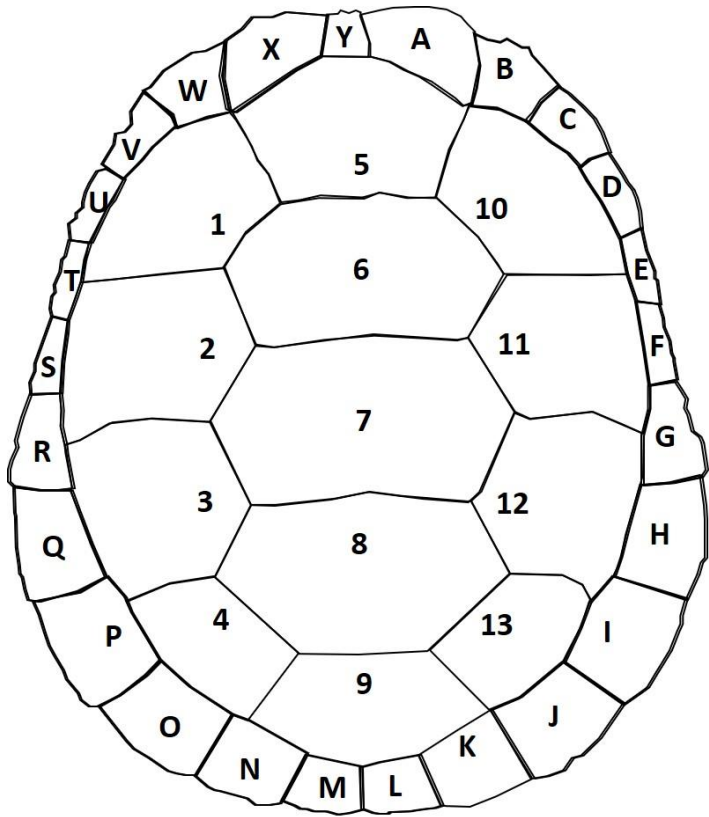

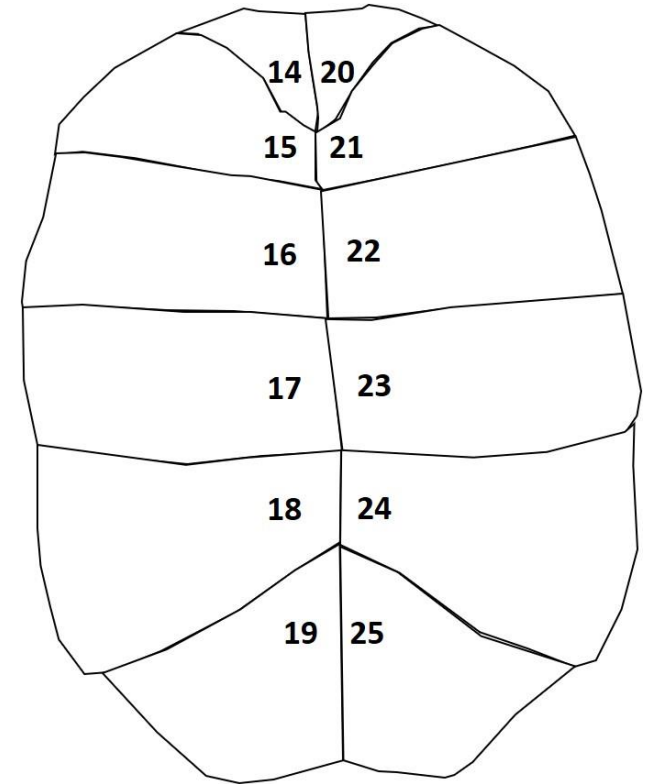

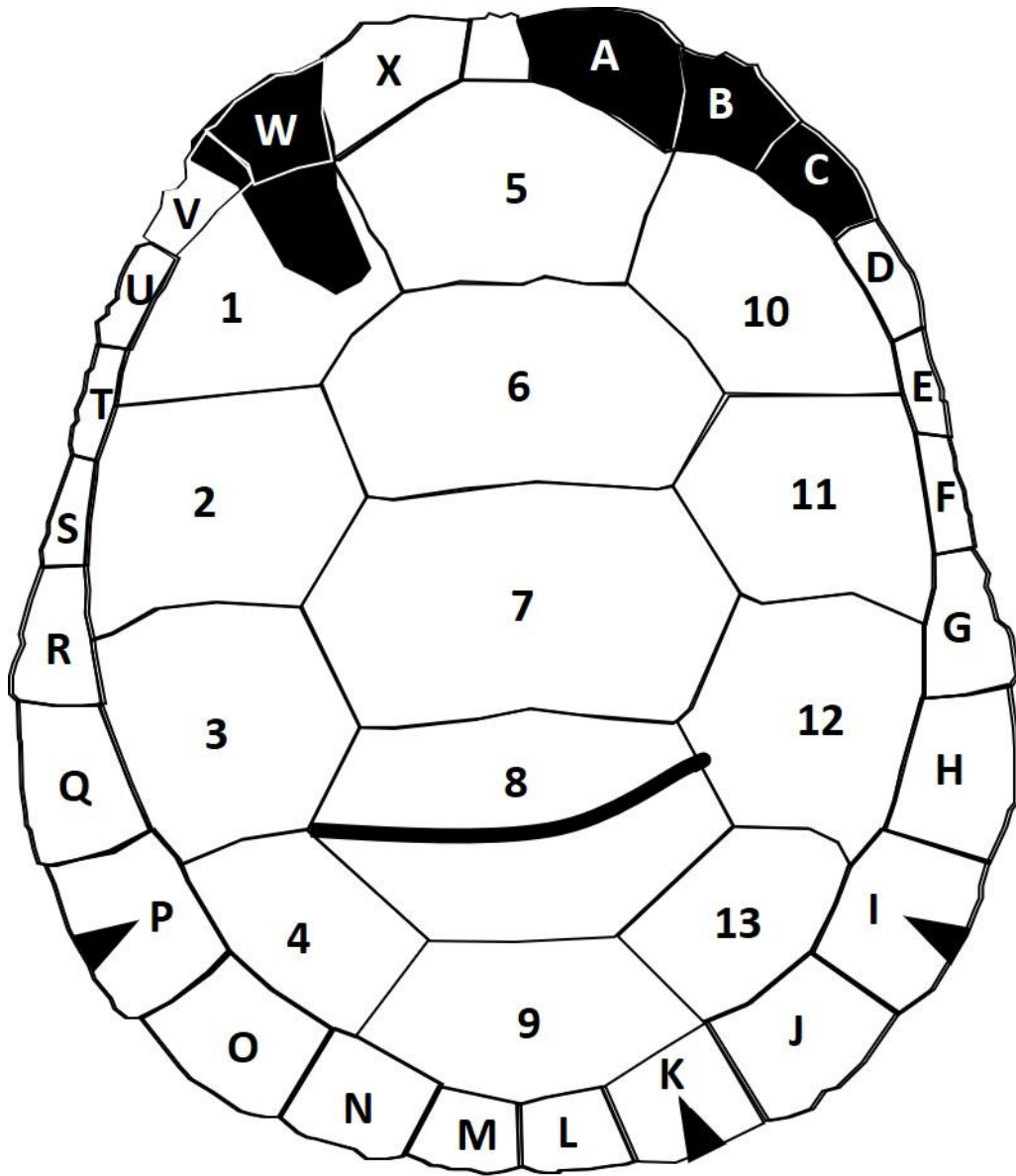

Injuries, abnormalities, and deformities can be drawn directly on the template above, by shading the injured area and describing it in the space provided.
