








- Mountains - early 1900's, escaped from hunting enclosure in NC




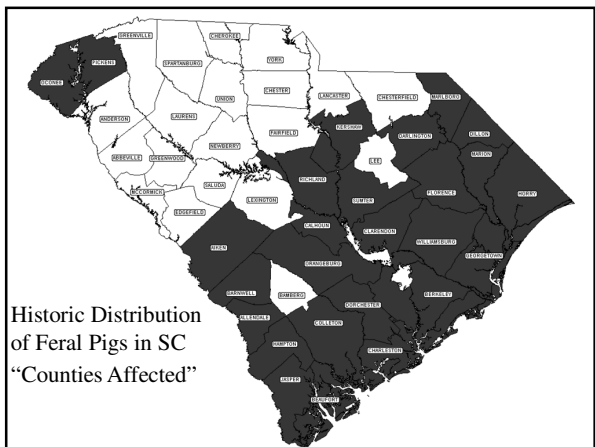

- Traditionally spread slowly by natural means.

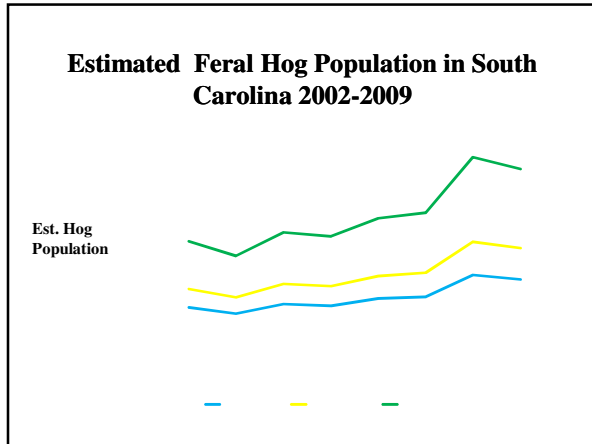


History of Feral Pigs in SC

- Recently spread has increased because of more introductions.

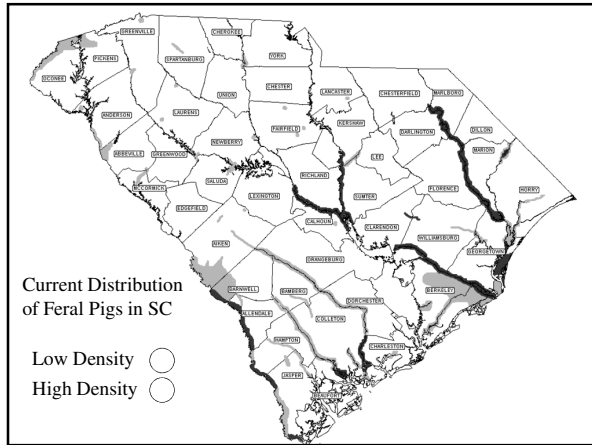
