Note: As of 2023-2024 waterfowl season, Bear Island WMA waterfowl harvest is reported as a whole property instead of by unit. The entire property is being hunted as a whole two days per week instead of as three separate units (East, West, Springfield/the Cut) three days per week. This change provides greater hunter opportunity, less disturbance, and improved sanctuary areas for ducks.
